## **STRATEGIC ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT (SEA)**

### **Introduction**

Strategic environmental assessment – or environmental/sustainability appraisal – is the process of assessing the impacts of policies, plans and programs on the environment (or on sustainability). SEA aims to make plans ‘greener’ and more sustainable.

### **Who should attend?**

The training seeks to gather up to 20 participants from sectorial ministries, in particular those responsible for economics, industry, agriculture and health, as well as representatives of donor agencies / International Financial Institutions, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), civil society, practitioners, planners, and environmental authorities & compliance officers

### **What are the benefits?**

- Define the context of decision making processes; the political, legal, economic and ecological systems;
- Define strategic actions - policies, plans and programs, and explain their roles in relation to societal objectives;
- Identify and describe the relationships between different strategic actions, i.e. policies, plans or programs;
- Explain i) why environmental considerations have not been appropriately integrated in strategic planning, decision-making and implementation, and ii) procedural, process and institutional factors that may affect the outcome (attaining environmental objectives) of a strategic action;
- Explain why environmental information needs to be adapted depending on the context and the level of a strategic action;
- Describe how strategic environmental assessment approaches can be adapted to different contexts and different levels of decision making, in developed and developing countries and in different institutional settings.
- Present working material, findings and conclusions orally and in written text
